RANGE RULES

The Club's Board of Directors spent over four months reviewing and revising the Range Rules. They had not been given an in-depth review for several years, and many members of the Board felt that they needed revision with an eye to clarifying and strengthening them in many key areas. The Board felt that the time invested was well worth the effort, as the Range Rules are one of the important keys to everyone's safety at the Club.

A great deal of thought and discussion went into the process, resulting in a completely revised and reworded document. The primary goal was to make the Range Rules clearer with regard to safety at the Club. The wording, and also the order that the various rules appear differs in many ways from the old version with which you are familiar. Rather than summarize the changes here, you and your guests are urged to save the enclosed copy, study it, and always follow the regulations.

**Abiding by the Range Rules is MANDATORY AT ALL TIMES
for EVERYONE using the Club's facilities.**

RIFLE & PISTOL RANGE HOURS: Rangemaster on duty 9:00 am to 4:00 pm - Saturday & Sunday
TRAP & SKEET PRACTICE: Trapmaster on duty 10:00 am to 4:00 pm - Wednesday, Saturday & Sunday
SKEET FIELD CLOSED DURING SPORTING CLAYS - TRAP FIELD OPEN - SIGN-UP CLOSES AT 10:30 AM

FEE CHANGES

The Board of Directors has made the following changes to the fees charged on the Rifle and Pistol Ranges. They are **EFFECTIVE 1 JANUARY 2011:**

THERE ARE NO CHANGES TO THE FEES CHARGED TO MEMBERS OF THE CLUB, with ONE exception. Juniors who are members of the Club shoot for free on the Rifle and Pistol Ranges whenever the Club is open to the general public.

NON-MEMBER FEES FOR SHOOTING WHEN THE CLUB IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC:

The fee paid by an adult non-member will include any accompanying youth(s) under 18 years old for the same fee.

ADULTS (18 and over): \$15.00 per day for both rifle and pistol. Includes accompanying Juniors.

IN MEMORIAM ROYCE S. REARWIN

The Club is saddened to learn of the passing of its long time members. Royce had the distinction of being the member with the longest unbroken membership. He joined the Club in 1965 - as an Annual Member at first, becoming Life Member Number 37 in 1976 - and kept his membership ever since - a string of 45 years of continuous membership.

Royce has not been active in the Club for several years. He moved to Belvedere Tiburon - it's a town of about 13,000 people located in Marin County on a peninsula that juts into San Francisco Bay - several years ago. Even though separated by many miles, he was always interested in his club, and enjoyed receiving the bulletin each month. The cause of Royce's death is not known by the Club, but he enjoyed a long and full life, having been born in September of 1910 - Not many reach the century mark.

The Club extends its sincere sympathy to Royce's family. So long, Royce. *Happy trails & Good Shooting.*

POLICY REGARDING NAMES IN THE BULLETIN

The bulletin is now available on the Club's World Wide Web site, which is viewable by anyone with web access. In order to protect the identities of the members, the following policy has been adopted regarding names placed in the bulletin. It would be time consuming and therefore expensive to create two different versions of the bulletin - one for mailing and another for the web, so the following will be used for all future editions of the monthly bulletin:

CLUB OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS: Their names are listed on the Club web site, so they will continue to be placed on the "masthead" of the bulletin.

ADVERTISEMENTS: They are listed on the Club web site as "supporters," and the adds will continue to run.

SCORES and REPORTS: Will use first names followed by the initial of the last name. "Tom Mud" will be shown as "Tom M."

MEMBERSHIP REPORTS: Will no longer list the names of the new members. They will show the number and types of memberships approved, but no names. They will also keep the running totals for the various classes of membership, as well as show the number of Life Memberships Available.

OBITUARIES will be handled on a case-by case basis.

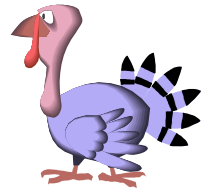
