## IDPA RESULTS

January 9, 2011

Event Director: Dennis H. Morales

A clear cool winter day was enjoyed by thirteen shooters until near the end of the shoot when a very cold breeze blew in some fog! The temperature dropped from the low 60s to 43F degrees with a wind-chill factor of about 38F! We welcomed three new shooters today: Martin Rudzinski, Freddy Warrick, and Michael Shierloh. Hope to see you guys back next month. Our goal this month was to get more trigger time with our handguns. We set up a simple scenario with variations so that all shooters could run through the course at least three times.

**Course:** Two target stands were set up at about 7 yards apart and about 7 yards in front of a barricade consisting of two stacked plastic barrels. Each stand had three paper plates. Two 6-round magazines or speed-loaders were required for each scenario.

**Scenario 1:** At the start of the timer, shooters had to engage the small paper plate targets on the right while behind cover and using two hands and double-tapping each paper plate. Next they had to reload six rounds and engage the targets on the left side of the barricade double-tapping the three small plates.

**Scenario 2:** The targets were moved in closer to the barricade and larger plates replaced the small ones. The drill was the same as in the first scenario except that shooters had to engage the right side targets strong hand only and the left, weak hand only.

**Scenario 3:** The right side target was moved out to about 15 yards from the barricade with the larger plates. The left large plate targets were left in the same place as the previous scenario. Again the drill was similar to the first scenario in that shooters had to engage the right side targets with both hands on the gun, but the left target was engaged weak hand only.

Jack Christen won the match with the best average score of 18.27 seconds with Neil Soman coming in a very close second at 19.60 seconds! Third place went to Rob Holcombe at 20.93. Only 2.66 seconds separating the top three scores. Fastest single scenario was 14.99 seconds by Dale Lowdermilk! Great shooting guys!

**Course:** Two target stands were set up at about 2 yards apart and about 7 yards in front and to the right of a barricade consisting of two plastic barrels placed side by side. The third target stand was located to the left of the barricade and about 8 yards in front of it. Each stand had two paper plates. Two 6-round magazines were required for this scenario.

**Scenario:** At the start of the timer, shooters had to engage the paper plate targets on the far right while behind cover, using two hands and shooting each paper plate once. Next, they had to engage the targets just to the left of the right one and shoot each plate once. Moving behind the

barricade, shooters had to do a "Tactical Reload" with one round still in the chamber and one round in the magazine, then place that magazine in a back pocket and insert the other six-round magazine. Shooters then engaged the two paper plate targets on the left side of the barricade shooting each twice. Next, the shooter had to reengage the first targets and shoot both paper plates once, move to the next target and shoot each plate once. However, because of the tactical reload, the shooter was short one round and had to change magazines once again replacing their now empty magazine with the first one they had placed in their back pocket containing only one round - enough ammo to shoot the last paper plate!

Every one completed the scenario twice.


Mike L. won the match with the lowest average score of 22.57 seconds! Rob H. came in a very close second only 0.17 seconds after Mike with a time of 22.74 seconds! Third place went to Mitch G. at 27.55. Congratulation guys!
