MEMBERSHIP CLARIFICATION

The Board of Directors has reduced the dues for University and College students under 25 years old. The dues are the same as for Juniors, and some confusion has occurred regarding the status of student members vs. junior members. The following should clarify everything:

STUDENT MEMBERSHIP

Age Requirements: Must be less than 25 years old
Academic Requirements: Must be enrolled in a University, College, Junior College or Trade School (i.e. Brooks)
Ducs: \$10.00 per year
Range Fees: Regular Member Fees apply
Shooting Requirements: None
Dues after turn 25: \$50.00 per year as long as Academic Requirements are met, otherwise Full Annual Membership
Range Fees after turn 25: Regular Member Fees Apply

JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP

Age Requirements: Must be less than 18 years old
Academic Requirements: None
Dues: \$10.00 per year
Range Fees: Shoot for Free on Rifle and Pistol ranges.
Shooting Requirements: Must be accompanied by Responsible Adult to shoot.
Dues after turn 18: Full Annual Membership unless qualified for Student Membership
Range Fees after turn 18: Regular Member Fees Apply

April 17, 2011: Lightning Lloyd and The Colonel set up and ran an informal match. No scores were kept. Our Posse Marshal was unable to attend due to a serious knee injury. When he will be able to return is unknown and we hope he recovers soon.

Welcome to new visiting shooter Lloyd's brother Jeff who did very well. Weather and conditions permitting the next cowboy match is scheduled for Sunday June 19 starting at 12:00 noon on the 200 yard range.

Be sure to call the Posse Marshal at (805) 886-5945 by the Friday before the match to confirm whether or not you will attend.

It was a cold spring morning for May's IDPA match up at the WCGC 200 Yard Range. We would like to welcome new shooters Warren, Casey, and Jim.

After a quick set up, 9 shooters participated in multiple scenarios that included; double tap drills, use of a flash light, and movement. The course was set up to engage two target stands with three paper plates on each- one at 7 yards and the other at 10 yards. The shooters stood behind a six ft barricade utilizing it for cover.

1st Scenario

Starts with 2 magazines, loaded with 6 rounds each, then the 3 targets are each hit with a double tap. First shoot on the right side target stand, and with a speed reload in between, double tap the 3 targets on the left.

2nd Scenario

Using 3 magazines, loaded with 6 rounds each, the same drill from the 1st scenario will be run with the

addition of a speed reload. After the last reload, shoot strong hand only- 1 shot at each target. Then go to weak hand only and shoot targets on the

other side.

3rd Scenario

After a brief instruction on flashlight use from Bill Tanner, shooters engage the right target with the flashlight in their weak hand- 2 shots at each of the 3 targets. Then reload and take 2 shots at each of the 3 targets on the left side, all while utilizing cover.

4th Scenario

The final stage involved moving from one barricade to another. The same target stands, with 3 paper plates on each were used. At the buzzer the standing shooter engages the right hand targets from a kneeling position- 2 shots at each target. After a speed reload from behind cover, the shooter moves to a barricade 10 yards to the left, takes cover and double taps the remaining 3 targets.


