The saying goes ♦A gun fight was never cancelled on account of bad weather♦. Thick fog and June gloom drizzle didn♦ stop 19 shooters from completing a challenging course of fire for this months shoot. Thanks to all the hard work and help from all of our shooters, we successfully completed another great match.

Welcome new shooters!

The course of fire was set up to test shooters with tactical reloads, speed reloads, hostage taker head shots, movement, and use of cover. Using the magazines in an improper sequence and shooting the hostage target resulted in a 5 second procedural error penalty. The use of a support hand on the second scenario, which was designated strong hand only, was also scored as a procedural error. Each

miss resulted in a 2.5 second penalty. Trouble at the ATM was the Scenario: Each stage began with 3 magazines loaded with 5 rounds each.

The First stage starts with one hand on your credit card in the ATM machine with your back to the targets. At the sound of the buzzer turn and engage the first 2 targets to your left. Shoot 1 shot at the hostage taker (head shot), then 2 shots center mass at the next target. Move to the box behind the barricade, do a tactical reload, cut the pie starting with the 2 targets on the left, 2 center mass, and 1 head shot each. Speed reload the engage the 2 targets on the right, cutting the pie with 2 shots center mass, 1 head shot each. From slide lock, speed reload using your first magazine to finish the course of fire. The second stage was same as the first stage using strong hand only.
