IN MEMORIAM - Paul Dixon Fritz

The Club has been shocked by the passing of yet another valued member. Paul Fritz passed on Sunday, 11 July with his family at his side.

Paul joined the Club in 1993, becoming a Life Member in the fall of 2000. He was a familiar face at the Trap field, and was a great supporter of the Club. He served on the Board of Directors for over two years. Paul was born in Los Angeles, California in July of 1941, the only child of Paul J. Fritz and Rosemary Weaver Fritz. He graduated from University High School, then obtained a BA in history from UCLA. He was on active duty with the US Coast Guard from 1965 to 1969, being discharged from the USCG Reserve in 1976. He married Carol Rossi, his wife of 40 years in 1970. He graduated from Loyola Law School in 1970 and began a 40 year carrier in law. He served as a Law Clerk, and was a partner in a local law firm. In 1986 he started his own firm "Creative Dispute Resolution" which offered an alternative to costly litigation. He was the first attorney to start a firm offering arbitration, mediation, and settlement conferences. Such work was usually done by retired judges. His choice to start such a firm blazed the trail for many attorneys who followed his lead.

Paul was very well known at the Club, and his good humor and kindness towards all he met will be sorely missed. The Club extends its sincere sympathies to his family, especially his wife Carol, his daughter Catherine, and his son Steven. *So long Paul. Happy trails and Good Shooting.*

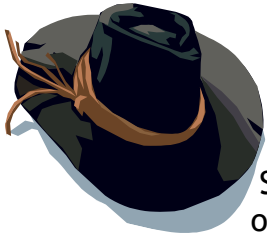

IDPA RESULTS

It was a beautiful, hot July morning for this months IDPA match. Another large turnout, 18 shooters ready to test their skills with the classic "El Presidente" scenario. Three targets were arranged at 5, 7, and 10 yards with 1 paper plate on each target. Starting with 2 magazines loaded with 6 rounds each, shooters placed 2 shots in each target. After moving to the right about 10 feet, they took cover behind a barricade, did a speed reload and engaged the three targets once again from behind cover.

The second stage started the same but once the shooter moved behind the barricade and speed reloaded it was right hand only from the right side of the barricade. Then after a third speed reload the 3 targets were engaged with the left hand only from the left side of the barricade.

We finished the match with an exciting man on man elimination using the "dueling tree." Read and Carlos faced off for the final round using weak hand only with Carlos coming out the winner. Way to go Carlos!

The Board of Directors has established the following policy regarding firearms owned by the Club:

WINCHESTER CANYON GUN CLUB

Firearms Loaner/Rental Policy and Procedure

Firearms for Loan or Rent at the Gun Club will be available to Club Members and Non-Club Members. **Non-Club Members** must have a **Club Member** in the immediate vicinity of the **Non-Club Members** monitoring the safe and proper use of shooting procedures on the Shotgun Fields or Rifle and Pistol Ranges.

Use of Club firearms by those participating in **Youth or Collegiate Programs** shall be under the direct supervision of a **Club Board approved Certified Instructor** and the responsibility of the **Event Chair** who will be present and in control of the firearms used by the participants. A Loaner/Rental form will not be necessary.

A Club Member or Non-Club Member can be responsible for more than one (1) person's Loaned or Rented Firearm in their party as listed on the Loaner/Rental Firearm registration form which is to be filled out by the Member or Non-Member, printed legibly and the information verified by a **Club Official** before any firearm is loaned or rented.

The Loaned/Rented firearm(s) will be assigned a number and the Club Official will be responsible for inventory and securing the firearm(s) when the Member or Non-Club Member is finished shooting.

The **Club's Firearm Safes** are to be kept locked at all times except when loaning or renting a firearm. If any firearm(s) are unaccounted for by the end of the day, the Club Official will immediately contact the Santa Barbara County Sheriff's Department and report a missing or stolen firearm and notify Club Officers.


