IDPA REPORT

Aug. 14 , 2011

We had a great turn-out for our August "3-Gun" IDPA match. Welcome new shooters Katrina, Eric G., Bryan, and Lloyd! It was a typical hot morning as 18 shooters tested their skills with tactical rifle, shotgun, and pistol. The scenario went like this:

Start with the tactical rifle (AR) with a pre loaded magazine containing 3 rounds placed next to the rifle. At the sound of the timer load the weapon with the 3 round magazine, engage the target stands with the IDPA targets at 10, 20, and 30 yards off hand Move to the shotgun. 3 target stands will be set out at 10, 20, and 30 yards with a clay pigeon tacked to each one. Then move to the 'dueling tree' at 10 yards and draw your pistol, you will have 2 magazines with 6 rounds in each. Load the pistol and move all 6 of the steel plates from the left to the right.

We all moved quickly through the scenario 3 times each today and all went well. The timed scenario began with the turning over 4 cards out of 6 which would determine the random sequence of targets that must be addressed in the same order and then place two hits per target before proceeding to the next one as was originally drawn by the shooter. The first run through was with both hands; the second was with the shooters 'strong hand only'; and the third was with 'the weak hand only'. For each miss there was a 3 second penalty; for each transgression out of sequence there was a 3 second penalty; for each target missed altogether there was a 5 second penalty. We finished up with a two man 'popper' challenge and those results are below, left.


